Willow Creek was established in September 1875 by Willard Albert Creek and was named after his late wife, Willow. It is said that she died in childbirth with their first child, Warren James Creek.

Willard was so distraught that he packed up just days after her death and moved across the state with his family and nanny until he found a piece of land uninhabited by others. That fall the first three houses were built and would eventually grow to what we know today.

To honor this monumental event, the town will hold a celebration on September 20, 2025. The planning has already begun and more details will be provided as we get closer.

One thing is for sure, Willard's descendants, Angelo Creek and his three daughters will be part of the festivities as we honor their part in Willow Creek history.
